# 8. Ordinance No. 91-05- Street & Alley (Tabled prior to 2<sup>nd</sup> reading - 6/13/05)

An ordinance changing the name of Alley No. 39, a fourteen (14') foot wide alley located approximately 200 feet west of South Main Street and parallel therewith and beginning at Bachtel Street S.W. and running in a north-south direction for approximately 1060 feet to Harmon Street S.W. and there terminating to Baker Court.

## 9. Ordinance No. 110-05 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading – Finance & Property

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to seek quotes on life insurance for the period December 1, 2005, through November 30, 2007, for the City of North Canton and for the Mayor of the City of North Canton to be authorized, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for said life insurance.

# 17. Resolution No. 136-05 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Community & Economic Development

Resolution No. 136-05 stating what municipal services will be provided to 4.815 acres of land, more or less, being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6 and the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 11 (Plain Township), Range 8, Stark County, Ohio, proposed to be annexed to the City of North Canton, in the event said territory is annexed to the City of North Canton, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
