8. Ordinance No. 43-05 – 3rd Reading – Parks & Recreation

An ordinance establishing the rates to be charged for season membership and daily admission for the City of North Canton Municipal Swimming Pool, and the rate for swimming lessons, and repealing any and all legislation inconsistent herewith.

9. Ordinance No. 45-05 – 3rd Reading – Street & Alley

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to sign a Replat of part of Out Lot 211 and Out Lot 318 located within the corporate limits of the City of North Canton, as situated in part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 11 (Plain Township), Range 8, Stark County Ohio, combining the two City owned parcels into one (1) Out Lot.

10. Ordinance No. 48-05 - 3rd Reading - Water, Sewer & Rubbish

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration; and for the Mayor to be authorized, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Hydraulic Elevator, for use by the Water Treatment Plant.

11. Ordinance No. 50-05 – 3rd Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims

An ordinance to provide for an election on the adoption of proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of North Canton.

12. Ordinance No. 51-05 - 2nd Reading - Personnel & Safety

Ordinance No. 51-05 amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Canton by the addition of Chapter 1508.

13. Ordinance No. 52-05 – 2nd Reading – Ordinance, Rules & Claims

An ordinance to approve, adopt, and enact the 2004 Residential Code of the Ohio for One-, Two- and Three-Family Dwellings, and subsequent editions or amendments as may hereinafter be adopted and promulgated by the International Code Council and the Ohio Building Officials Association for the City of North Canton, Ohio, together with all changes, amendments, and revisions thereto and incorporated herein as "Attachment A," save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, amended, or modified by these Regulations, are regulating the fabrication, erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, location, and use of detached one-, two- and three-family dwellings, their appurtenances and accessory structures in the jurisdiction of the City of North Canton, Ohio; and providing for the issuance of permits therefore providing penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith, with the exception of Appendix B, C, and D of the North Canton Building Code.

14. Ordinance No. 53-05 – 2nd Reading – Finance & Property

Ordinance No. 53-05 establishing rental rates and policies for rental of the North Canton Civic Center and repealing any and all legislation passed previously and inconsistent with this ordinance.

15. Ordinance No. 54-05 – 2nd Reading – Finance & Property

Ordinance No. 54-05 establishing rental rates and policies for rental of the North Canton Dogwood Park Shelter located at 241 Seventh Street NE, and repealing any and all legislation passed previously and inconsistent with this ordinance.

16. Ordinance No. 59-05 - 1st Reading - Street & Alley

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the office of the Director of Administration; and for the Mayor to be authorized, through the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for the James Street Improvements project, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

17. Ordinance No. 60-05 – 1st Reading – Water, Sewer & Rubbish

18. Ordinance No. 61-05 – 1st Reading – Water, Sewer & Rubbish

An ordinance adopting the Solid Waste Management Plan for the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Solid Waste Management District.

19. Ordinance No. 62-05 - 1st Reading - Finance & Property

Ordinance No. 62-05 amending Appendix "A" of Ordinance No. 159-04, Appropriation Ordinance of the City of North Canton, to include the purchase of three new vehicles for use by the Engineering Department, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to apply for, accept, and enter into a loan agreement through the Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) in the Ohio Drinking Water Assistance Fund on behalf of the City of North Canton for planning, design and/or construction of drinking water facilities and designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan, and declaring the same to be an emergency.
